

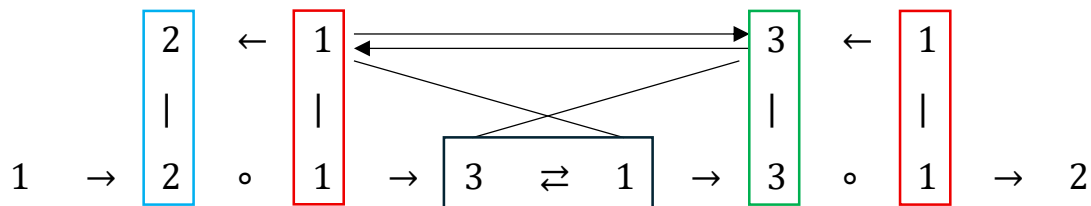
Dissemination von Vermittlung in der Diamond-Semiotik

2. Diamondstrukturen disseminierter semiotischer Vermittlung

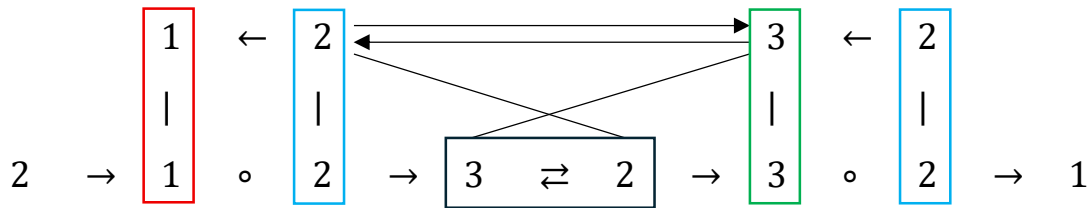
2.1. $V(3, 1)$

$$\mathcal{D}^1 = [\mathfrak{B}[(1, 2, 3), (2 \leftarrow 1)], \mathfrak{B}[(1, 3, 2), (3 \leftarrow 1)]]$$



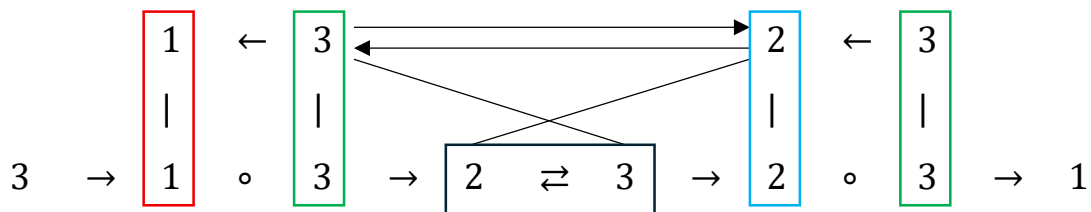
2.2. $V(3, 2)$

$$\mathcal{D}^2 = [\mathfrak{B}[(2, 1, 3), (1 \leftarrow 2)], \mathfrak{B}[(2, 3, 1), (3 \leftarrow 2)]]$$



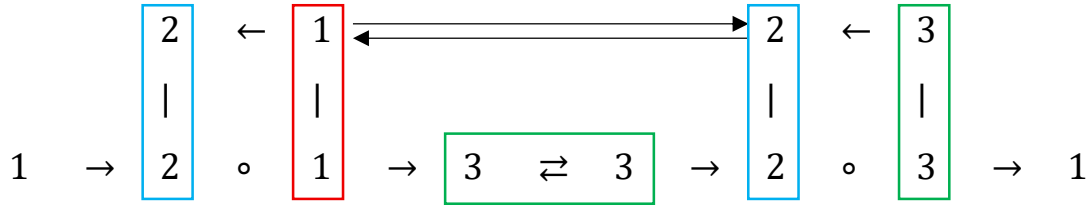
2.3. $V(2, 3)$

$$\mathcal{D}^3 = [\mathfrak{B}[(3, 1, 2), (1 \leftarrow 3)], \mathfrak{B}[(3, 2, 1), (2 \leftarrow 3)]]$$



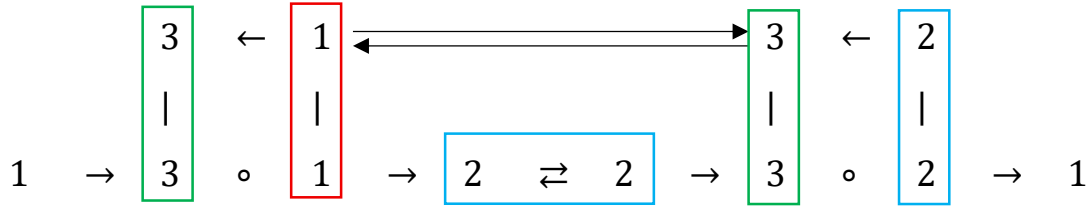
2.4. $V(3, 3)$

$$\mathcal{D}^4 = [\mathfrak{B}[(1, 2, 3), (2 \leftarrow 1)], \mathfrak{B}[(3, 2, 1), (2 \leftarrow 3)]]$$



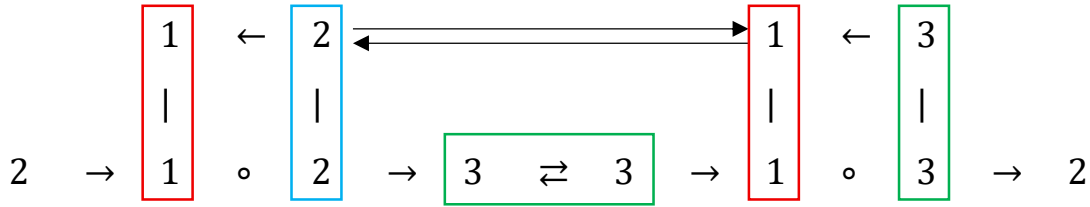
2.5. $V(2, 2)$

$$\mathcal{D}^5 = [\mathfrak{B}[(1, 3, 2), (3 \leftarrow 1)], \mathfrak{B}[(2, 3, 1), (3 \leftarrow 2)]]$$



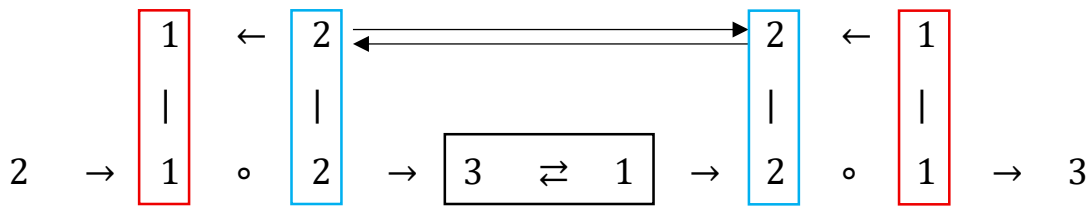
2.6. $V(3, 3)$

$$\mathcal{D}^6 = [\mathfrak{B}[(2, 1, 3), (1 \leftarrow 2)], \mathfrak{B}[(3, 1, 2), (1 \leftarrow 3)]]$$



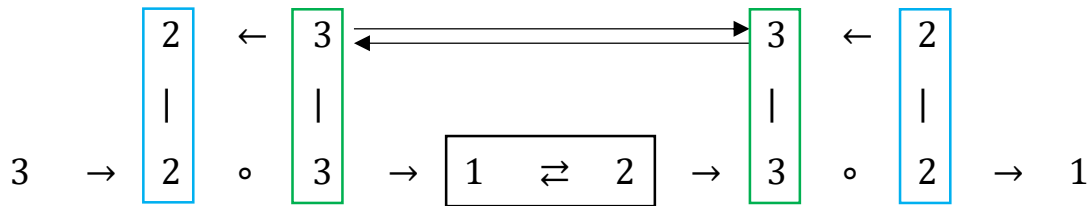
2.7. $V(3, 1)$

$$\mathcal{D}^7 = [\mathfrak{B}[(2, 1, 3, (1 \leftarrow 2))], \mathfrak{B}[(1, 2, 3), (2 \leftarrow 1)]]$$



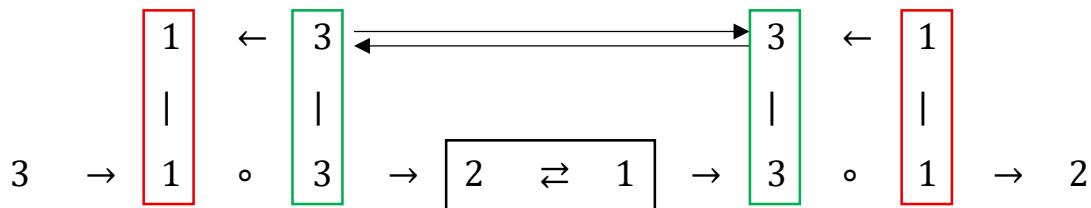
2.8. $V(1, 2)$

$$\mathcal{D}^8 = [\mathfrak{B}[(3, 2, 1), (2 \leftarrow 3)], \mathfrak{B}[(2, 3, 1), (3 \leftarrow 2)]]$$



2.9. $V(2, 1)$

$$\mathcal{D}^9 = [\mathfrak{B}[(3, 1, 2), (1 \leftarrow 3)], \mathfrak{B}[(1, 3, 2), (3 \leftarrow 1)]]$$
